 - D. He doesn't promise a "wrinkle-free" life, but that He will be with us

 - 1. That is the answer to our fear, worry and anxiety
 - 2. His presence puts problems in the right perspective
 - 3. His presence is the only thing that makes everything possible

 - 2. He saw God at work
