As a young man I was caught in the Performance Trap. I was pushing myself to an extreme to accomplish, achieve and produce. My goal was to get to manage the largest volume store in the chain. I accomplished that goal in my early 20's, but lost my family in the process. It was then, in my store in New Orleans that I realized... You lose sucker! You see, I had accomplished my goal and produced great results, but to the neglect of the people closest to me. To the neglect of relationships.

At that point I turned my heart toward God and began to seek how I could make this right with Him. I began to attend churches on St. Charles Street, but encountered missionaries sharing their story about their mission's trip to Africa or India. I never heard the Gospel.

I am convinced that God knows our heart. He knew I was seeking Him. He sent someone (Sandy Sherman) to come work in my crew that was a Christian. He walked the walk for three months. He had a joy and a peace and a contentment that I didn't have. I wondered what the difference was with him?

One Saturday afternoon he asked if we could talk after work. I agreed. After we locked up, we went to the stockroom to talk. He shared with me the Roman Road to Salvation...how the Apostle in the book of Romans had written that we all are sinners (3:23), that the wages of our sin is death, but that God offers eternal life to all who will put their faith in Jesus (6:23). He went on to say that God loves sinners (5:8). Then he explained that Jesus is the Savior to all who believe in Him as Lord of all. Having explained that Lord means King, Ruler, Master; he then as me this question. "Mr. LoBello, what are you going do with Jesus?"

That night, in all sincerity I ask God to forgive me my sin and accepted Jesus as my Savior and Lord. I placed my faith in Jesus to save me. I was casting myself on the mercy of God, accepting His grace gift of salvation found in Jesus, God's Son. Immediately I felt the weight of my sins removed from me. I was filled with gratitude for Jesus who shed His blood and gave His life for my salvation.

He was loving and kind and gentle in his relationships. I thought to myself, "This guy is a fake. He's a counterfeit. There is no way he can be that loving and kind and gentle!"

Do you see what's happening? God is doing it AGAIN! At a time in my life when I needed a greater vision...a better understanding of who God was calling me to be as a Christian...God brought someone in my path to show me what it looks like.





KIDS: FROM IDENTIFY LOST TO IDENTITY FOUND

It seems like summer flew by, and now your kids are getting ready to head back to school. They will be reconnecting with friends, meeting new teachers, creating new relationships, and quite possibly for them, experiencing new things, things we aren't ready for.

It only takes a few minutes of watching the headlines to see where our world is headed, and headed there quickly. In my job, we see these new worldviews affecting our kids in a big way. In talking with our preteens, it is evident that our kids are being exposed to things way too young, and they are being forced to make decisions that they shouldn't have to make. It's imperative that they don't make these decisions alone.


In the *The Disappearing Church*, Mark Sayers talks about a list of seven core beliefs that reflect an individualist society, ranging from believing that the highest good is individual freedom and self-expression, to believing that all forms of external authority should be rejected. We are seeing this play out in our kids, preteens and youth. And for many, it's innocent because they are hyper-exposed to these beliefs through TV, social media influencers, gaming and peers.

So what can you do? As a parent, **you** are the first line of defense. It is up to you to talk with your child and have real conversations every day. During your conversations, see if you can pick up on any of these viewpoints in your child:

- They feel that "Jesus is the only way" seems intolerant.
- They challenge that the biblical teaching about binary gender is bigoted and unsafe.
- They talk about themselves as a "brand"
- They refer to "my truth" rather than "the truth."
- They celebrate the decisions of others, regardless of behavior.
- They fall to peer pressure to stay popular or in the loop.
- They know when they (or friends) have been included in something that is wrong, but they stay silent because of peer pressure or status.

The world wants your children and we have to be ready to fight the good fight. *If I can ask you to do one thing right now, it is this:*

Tell your child TODAY that you are there for them. That they can feel safe telling you anything. That you can't protect them (from whatever it may be) if you don't know what's going on. Tell them that while some actions will still have consequences, you are still "FOR THEM." That you will work through whatever it is together. Above all, they need to understand that they can't do anything that would make you love them less.



Be prepared to hear things you don't want to hear, and deal with situations you don't want to deal with. Most importantly, be prepared to offer healing and restoration with these four truths:

GOD KNOWS YOU.

Hebrews 4:13 says that nothing in all creation can hide from God. There is no place kids and students can go that He cannot see them. He already knows their thoughts and intentions. And even thought He knows everything about us, He still loves us.

GOD DESIGNED YOU.

Colossians 1:16 tell us that God made everything in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible.

Ephesians 2:10 reads "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Even though the worldview would have you believe that you are random, a product of chance, or even a mistake, God says differently.

GOD IS ALWAYS WITH YOU.

Isaiah 41:10 says "Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will hold on to you with my righteous right hand." God promises to be with us no matter what happens.

GOD LOVES YOU.

1 John 3:1a tells us "See what great love the Father has given us that we should be called God's children - and we are! God did not wait for us to love Him, He loved us first. You are loved by God.

Guiding your child through these tough times is hard, and we don't want you to do it alone. Helping your child find their identity in Christ is crucial. We are here for you for support and guidance. Let us know if there is anything we can do to help.

HELPING THE MOST HELPLESS AMONG US

The last few months have brought forth a whirlwind of blessings from the Lord as we have launched this new ministry at Live Oak Church. On Thursday, June 29th, our Church hosted a lunch and learn for our pastors, our counselors and our laity that have shared a desire to take part in this new ministry. We welcomed the Clinic Manager, Stephanie Saavedra, and the Lead Therapist, Elizabeth Wilson, from Woman's New Life Clinic (WNLC) who came and presented to us on crisis management, the status of abortion in Louisiana, the abortion pill, and grief counseling and healing for those ladies and families who have had abortions, miscarried and/ or lost a newborn or infant. WNLC is a Christian organization that provides life-affirming medical care, mental health care and material care to women in crisis, unplanned pregnancies, and various circumstances where the struggle is bigger than they are. WNLC has two clinics, one is in the Baton Rouge area and the other is in New Orleans. They are very passionate about their mission, and the information they brought to our group was invaluable, and it will help us, help others in the days to come.



Just ten days later, on the afternoon of Sunday, July 9th, our Church hosted an Educational Conference for people in our general congregation who are interested in learning more about what's happening in our state and in our community regarding abortion, and many others who have shown interest in taking part in this ministry and its future development. We had over 70 attendees, and we had a wonderful time of fellowship, breaking bread, and engaging



in the presentations while soaking up all the information that was shared. At the Conference we had three speakers: Charles and Clelie Carpenter from Baton Rouge Right to Life, and Allison Daigle, CEO of Woman's New Life Clinic (WNLC).

Mr. Charles and Mrs. Clelie spoke on the legal landscape of abortion in the United States and in Louisiana, the full humanity of the fetus beginning at conception, and pro-choice arguments along with necessary rebuttals. Afterwards, Mrs. Allison gave a powerful talk on the mission and work of her organization at the WNLC. She explained how they provide counseling to men and women in unplanned pregnancy situations. They also provide low-cost women's health care, material assistance, referral for adoption and other life affirming services. Mrs. Allison emphasized their role in fertility awareness education as well, and how they inform their clients that abstinence is the only guaranteed way to avoid pregnancy. Care Net (1) reports 86% of abortions are among unmarried women, and this helps even further affirm God's design for marriage, where husband and wife "become one flesh" (Genesis 2:24, Malachi 2:15, Matthew 19:4-6) and from that point on, He calls them "to be fruitful and multiply" (Genesis 9:7).

At the conclusion of the presentations, there were many good conversations where more ideas were shared on how we can proceed forward, and this brings us to the big question of "Where do we go from here?" For starters, we have formed a leadership team that will be meeting in the short term to make plans for the second half of the year ahead. We are looking forward to having another Educational Conference in the fall of 2023 which will be opened to our congregation as well, and in the new year, we are looking into starting a small, focused group with plans to

take a deeper dive into the topic of abortion, its surrounding issues, and how we might make an even larger impact in our community for those with unplanned pregnancies. We will continue to foster our relationships with life affirming pregnancy centers and programs, which will help us build a robust program for referring those in need and connecting them to the proper resources.

We are very excited to see what the Lord has been doing already through this ministry in stirring up the hearts of His people in a powerful way! We look forward to what the Lord will do in the future in and through Live Oak Church, so we can continue to be a light in the darkness that surrounds us. We are called to do good to all people, especially to those of the household of the faith (Galatians 6:10). Please continue to keep this ministry in your prayers. Pray that God will give us wisdom as we proceed forward. Pray that He will stir the hearts of the visionaries of this ministry, empower the counselors and pastors of Live Oak Church to minister to those in need, and that He strengthen our relationships with others in our community so that the impact will be broad, and that He will receive the glory for this mission and ministry.

Be on the lookout for future articles, advertisements and events as we share more educational tidbits in hopes to increase awareness and provide knowledge and tools to the people of our Church, to witness and refer those in need.


A DROP FROM THE ALTAR by sam lobello


