 - (1) Jesus died by Roman crucifixion
 - (2) Jesus was buried in a private tomb
 - (3) His followers were discouraged
 - (4) His tomb was found empty
 - (5) His disciples believed they actually saw and spoke with Jesus after the empty tomb was found
 - (6) Because of this their lives were transformed
 - (7) From the very beginning, the early church taught the resurrection of Jesus
 - (8) His disciples proclaimed the resurrection of Jesus in Jerusalem which is the same city he was killed in
 - (9) The entire message of the early church was all about the death burial and resurrection of Jesus
 - (10) Sunday became the primary day of gathering and was called the Lord's day because that is the day of the week the resurrection took place on
 - (11) James the ½ Brother of Jesus was a skeptic before he was converted
 - (12) Just a few years later, the extreme skeptic Saul who publicly persecuted Christians became one because he believed he saw and spoke with the risen Jesus.
