





arly in my seminary education I was in class and the Professor asked us students to share our personal testimonies. Each one of us shared about our life before we came to know Christ. We talked about our shortcomings. This revealed our sin problem that had separated us from a holy God.

Then we shared how we had come to realize our need of Christ. When I was growing up my brothers were often getting into trouble at school and as they got older, with the law. I would see what they were doing and thought that compared to them I would shake out just fine. Then the girl I had dated in High School and married divorced me. God used that to help me realize my need of Him.

Next, we began to share how we accepted Christ, how we were saved. Some had accepted Christ in Vacation Bible School, others had accepted Christ into their life during revival services, and then there were others who were led to faith in Christ as they were going about their life. For me, it was in the stockroom of my store that I surrendered my life to Christ.

When we were done sharing, the professor then asked, "But, what about your life since you accepted Christ? Shouldn't that be a part of your testimony, as well? I mean, has Christ made any difference in your life?" This sent the gears to turning in our heads. It caused us to reflect over our life and discover the difference Christ does indeed make in the lives of all who enter into a relationship with Him.



It reminds me of the words of a Protestant hymn..." What a wonderful change in my life has been wrought, since Jesus came into my heart!" And another..."This is my story this is my song, praising of my Savior all the day long."

s we lead people to worship God, His presence is the utmost priority in all we do. In Exodus, when God calls Moses to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land, Moses tells God: "If your presence will not go, do not carry us up from here. For how shall it be known that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people, unless you go with us. In this way, we shall be distinct, I and your people, from every people on the face of the earth." (Ex. 33:15-16). Moses is essentially saying, "If your presence doesn't go, I'm not going. If you're not with me, what will distinguish me?" Without God's presence, there is no purpose nor any power to anything we do.

Along these same lines, Chris Tomlin said, "The presence of God is the difference maker. It's not our guitars. We're not making up new chords...I know how to play the right things. That's all well and great, but that'll only last for the night. WHAT WILL BE A MARKER ON PEOPLE'S LIVES IS IF THEY REALLY SENSE THE PRESENCE OF GOD."

The responsibility and role of a worship leader finds its origin in the Levites in the Old Testament. The Levites were one of the 12 tribes of Israel; they were a tribe of temple servants who interceded for the people. Their purpose was to usher people into the presence of God by filling roles as priests, judges, gatekeepers, craftsmen, singers and musicians. Their charge was divinely appointed. It was specifically defined by God in Scripture. So when it came to the temple, or the throne room of God, their efforts would all fall short if they tried to "perform," putting the focus on themselves or their own role. Levites weren't performing. They were ushering people into the presence of God.

Worship leaders are in many ways continuing this divinely appointed task of ushering people into the presence of God. Their calling provides an awesome

reminder to walk in the presence of God in our own lives first - through personal worship and devotion and then to lead His people from

the overflow of our devotion. What we offer is not what we can do or bring to the table, it's about what the Savior offers us through His redemptive work in creation. Louie Giglio said, "WE'RE NOT OFFERING A SHOW, WE'RE HOLDING OUT A SAVIOR."


Our heart as worship leaders at Live Oak is for everyone to sense the presence of God closer and closer each day. We are called to foster points of connection between people and their Savior, to usher people into the very presence of God, and to encourage everyone to "draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings" (Heb. 10:22). We lead people to come before God with hearts tuned to His truths, to come before the throne of God in a spirit of HOLY EXPECTANCY - expecting to see God move in our midst, and expecting to see lives changed. How could we ever grow tired of God's presence? How could we not be in awe of what is taking place in worship? Whether we are in a room full of people lifting praises through the power of congregational singing, or in an individual time of devotion where God reveals His Word to us in a new and fresh way, we are drawing closer to the presence of God in worship.

Authentic worship of the Savior isn't confined to a church service, or even a particular music style; it's a posture of the heart, meeting with God and ascribing worth to Him (John 4:19-26). Our role as worship leaders is to encourage and equip our people to have a growing relationship with Christ. To point our people to worship Him more fully. To come before Him with holy expectancy. This is why the mission of Live Oak Worship is to FOSTER ENVIRONMENTS THAT ENCOURAGE PEOPLE TO ACTIVELY **ENGAGE IN WORSHIP.** We know, as Moses and the Levites did, and as Chris Tomlin stated, the presence of God is the difference maker. The presence of God is where true power is. Without the presence of God, nothing we do matters. We will fall short every time if we try to move or lead in our own power or efforts. It's only when people come before God, seeking His heart in worship, He promises to meet us there and our lives are truly changed.





Why do I tell you all of these things? These women don't know who to turn too, because they don't know the women in this church. I don't know where to lead them, because

We don't always understand why we go through a trial, but I firmly believe part of that reason is so that we can help those that come behind us that are going through the same trial.

Live Oak Ladies.... I love each and every one of you. I pray for you and I ask that you pray for me. Above all, I ask that you get to know other ladies in our church and reach out and ask how you can pray for them. 
