- II. How to journey through the crisis
 - A. Examine your picture (blue print) in light of life's condition
 - B. Follow Jesus and lead like Him
 - 1. Leadership is crucial
 - 2. Without leadership there is anarchy
 - 3. Know your mission message, your ministry
 - 4. Love the one you follow (Jesus)
 - 5. Beware of how Judas followed and Peter's problem
 - 6. Know your leadership style
 - a. Process leader
 - b. Pivotal leader

- C. Find (be in) community
 - 1. Who are you traveling with on this journey
 - 2. Isolation causes devastation
 - 3. Not good to be alone (made for relationship)
 - 4. Crisis separates the real from the pretend
- D. Search for God's will and timing
- E. Beware of the pride that ruins you
- F. Beware of the anxiety and depression that wants to crush you
- G. Beware of the "roaring lion" that wants to destroy
