 - 1. Families
 - 2. Homes
- C. Pride destroys churches
- D. Pride destroys nations

- G. People who struggle with pride don't always recognize it is pride that is destroying them

- A. Pride is not having a good self-image
 - 1. Being pleased with job well done
 - 2. Being pleased with accomplishment of others
- B. As followers of Jesus, we have benefits that we

- can be excited and grateful
- C. Humility is not thinking lowly of yourself It's not thinking of yourself

V. What is pride?

- A. Going through life independent of God
 - 1. Telling God "stay out"
 - 2. I am master of my ship
 - 3. I am captain of my soul
- B. Pride is a spirit of ingratitude
 - 1. Entitlement
 - 2. Expectation
- C. Esteeming yourself as better than others
- D. Pride is at war with God
 - 1. God is opposed to the proud (James 4:6)
 - 2. Pride brings hell up

VI. Symptoms of pride

- A. Irritation when corrected for mistakes
- B. Pride doesn't admit to mistakes
- C. Pride has no sense of loyalty or attachment
- D. Pride refuses to take counsel or learn from others
- E. Pride has an ungrateful spirit for all that God has done
- F. Pride is in constant competition with other people to prove superiority

VII. How pride will ruin your life

- A. Pride defies God
 - 1. Adam and Eve
 - 2. Lucifer (Isaiah 14)
 - a. I will ascend
 - b. I will exalt
 - c. I will be like most high
 - 3. The cornerstone of atheism is pride
- B. Pride defiles humanity

- 1. It comes out of our sin nature (Mark 7:21-22)
- 2. Never thankful
- 3. Never acknowledges
- 4. Never recognizes
- C. Pride divides people
 - 1. Families divide
 - 2. Relationships end
 - 3. Churches split
 - 4. War is declared
 - 5. Takes you out of fellowship with God
 - 6. Arguments are about pride
 - 7. Pride creates contention
- D. Pride dishonors life
 - 1. Domestic ruin
 - 2. National ruin
 - 3. Financial ruin
 - 4. Emotional ruin
- E. Pride devastates life
 - 1. It causes failure
 - 2. It causes you to fall
 - 3. It brings you low
- F. Pride destroys the soul
 - 1. Story of 2 people in the temple
 - 2. One left dignified, one left justified

 - 1. A giver not a taker
 - 2. A servant, not selfish
- B. Blesses
 - 1. Marriages
 - 2. Families
 - 3. Churches
 - 4. Communities

- C. It's a journey not a destination, a constant pursuit
- D. Attributes
 - 1. Meet people where they are
 - 2. Serve
 - 3. Apologize
 - 4. Listen
- E. Formula:

Proud + Proud = Battle

Proud + Humble = Abuse

Humble + Humble = Blessing

- F. How do you measure where you are?
