- I. His declarations affect you and your future**
 - A. He declared He was/is the “Great I Am”
- II. His message in the synagogue declared His: fame, claim, aim (What He would proclaim and our gain)**
- III. His Fame**
 - A. He was a known miracle worker
 - B. He was loved by the masses
 - C. He was seen doing great things
 - D. His words and works were written and shared
- IV. His claim (the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy)**
 - A. Born in Bethlehem/specific ancestry
 - B. A worker of miracles
 - C. Death by Crucifixion
 - D. Rising from the dead
- V. His aim**
 - A. Deliver us from bondage (strongholds)
 - B. Deliver the blind
 1. Physically
 2. Spiritually
 3. Psychologically
 - C. Deliver those bankrupt in life
 - D. Deliver those broken by life
 - E. Deliver those beaten down
- VI. What Jesus and His followers would proclaim (10 primary areas/reasons for coming into the world)**
 - A. To proclaim the future life, eternal hope, to all who would believe
 1. Trusting in Him
 2. Paradise
 - B. To be the mediator between God and humanity
 1. One mediator between God and humanity
 - C. To express and demonstrate God’s grace, God’s love to those who felt hopeless
 1. Woman at the well
 2. Woman caught in adultery
 3. Tax collector – Zacchaeus
 4. Roman Centurion – pagan, but had faith in Jesus

- D. To sympathize with our situation in life
 - 1. The complaints
 - 2. The criticism
 - 3. The contempt
- E. To fulfill the prophecies of God
 - 1. Proving the inspiration of Scripture
 - 2. Proving God watches over His Word
- F. To be our substitute payment on the cross
 - 1. It is finished
- G. To destroy and defeat death in the power of the resurrection
- H. To give us the pattern for the resurrection
 - 1. First fruits
- I. To represent us before God
- J. To be our pattern for life
 - 1. What did Jesus do?
 - 2. What would Jesus do?
 - 3. Help me to look more like Jesus

VII. Our gain (10 primary areas)

- A. God's grace (never stops)
- B. God's forgiveness (past, present, future)
- C. Adopted by God
- D. Invited into His Kingdom
- E. Life, hope and confidence
- F. Answers to life's questions
- G. A Savior who never leaves us
- H. A home in heaven
- I. A role/place in His Kingdom
- J. A life that never ends in the joy and beauty of paradise

VIII. We all enter the same (3 things we must understand/believe)

- A. I am a sinner/fallen short, messed up
- B. I need a Savior (I cannot save myself)
- C. I believe Jesus is the Messiah, the one who can save me from judgement, eternal separation from God, and who can and will provide heaven as a free gift.
