- A. God took us in a direction we never thought we would go
- B. I never thought this is where I would be
- C. Nicodemus and the rebirth John 3:3
- D. Jesus introduced him to a life he never fully understood until he met Jesus
- E. Jesus showed him seven things
 - 1. He is the Messiah
 - 2. Nicodemus is not saved by the rules
 - 3. That rebirth is believing in Him
 - 4. That God made a way to give grace
 - 5. Nicodemus can have purpose in life
 - 6. Can have Eternal life
 - 7. Can know God as his Heavenly Father

II. The Apostle Paul created three categories of people as they relate to God

- A. The natural person man
 - 1. Alive physically dead spiritually
 - a. A computer with no battery
 - 2. No activation for the things of God
 - 3. No appreciation for the things of God

- 4. Spiritual principles and promises are foolishness
- 5. No spiritual appropriation
 - a. Eyes but cannot see
 - b. Ears but cannot hear
- B. The other end The spiritual person
 - 1. Born of the Spirit
 - 2. Live by the Spirit
 - 3. Learn from the Spirit of God via the Word of God
 - 4. Liberated through the Spirit
- C. The most miserable The carnal Christian
 - Saved but shallow
 - a. Restricted development
 - b. Restricted in spiritual diet
 - c. Repeatedly divided
 - d. Elvis was an example

 - 2. A life that ends never using the talents, chasing the dreams, having a vision is a tragedy
