 - 3. Fault finding is their gift
 - 4. Seek to control others
 - 5. Pride permeates their soul
 - 6. Prayer is more a performance
 - 7. "I" is the focus of all things
- B. Substitute Seekers
 - 1. Not willing to turn to Jesus for life
- C. Self-Deceived
 - 1. Create their own theology
- D. Spiritually resistant
- E. Sarcastic toward the sacred

 - 3. Wonder/awe/imagination

 - 1. Jesus the Perfect King

- 3. Work to do and Wisdom to gain in the Kingdom
- C. Heaven is a city
 - 1. Opportunity
 - 2. People together
 - 3. Sports, art, entertainment
 - 4. Open, joyful
 - 5. No problems
 - 6. Dining, festivals
 - 7. Holy Days of joy
- D. Heaven is a home
 - 1. A place
 - 2. A people enjoying life together
 - 3. Your home
 - 4. Settled for eternity
 - 5. With the Lord
- E. Heaven is a garden
 - 1. We love parks
 - 2. We love golf courses
 - 3. Flowers
 - 4. Manicured pristine areas
 - 5. Beaches, resorts
 - 6. Rivers
- F. Heaven is a celebration
 - 1. Cheering, joy
 - 2. Homecoming joy
 - 3. Like a wedding reception
 - 4. {Remember when we could not gather together, fellowship, worship together, no sporting events, no family events, depression took over}
 - 5. Jesus provide richly for a wedding reception (John 2)
 - 6. Jesus compared the Kingdom to wedding reception (Matthew 22)
