 - 1. Children shouldn't be responsible for the consequences of a parent's irresponsibility

- B. <u>Teach</u>: Impress the things of God on your children
 - 1. Make faith a priority in your home and the church building
 - 2. The parents/family reputation cannot be the reason for Christian behavior
- C. <u>Discipline</u>: Implement healthy discipline
 - 1. Mistakes, Accidents, Negligence, and Aggression all require different responses
- D. <u>Regulate</u>: Create an environment of emotional stability
 - 1. Do not provoke your children to anger
 - i. Abate your anger
 - ii. Assuage their anger
 - iii. Adjust the physical environment
 - iv. Attune to their emotions
 - v. Apologize when you are wrong
- E. <u>Invest</u>: Be intentional
 - 1. Parent on purpose. Parent with purpose
 - i. What do you want them to become?
 - ii. What do you want them to accomplish?
 - iii. How do you want your kids to live?
