 - 2. Crops destroyed
 - 3. Disease carried
- C. Pollution of water
- D. Weather disasters
 - 1. Hail
 - 2. Wind

- E. Invasion (enemies)

- E. When the worship of and prayer to false gods occur in the nations temple
- F. Apostasy leaving the Word, leaving the worship
- G. When a nation turns against Israel
