- I. Where does this confusion come from?
  - A. The various views and terms used in churches, not found in the Bible
  - B. This misrepresentation as seen on TV or at events not endorsed by Scripture
  - C. People making claims that were not legitimate
  - D. Some have been told if you don't have a certain experience, you are not saved
- II. What does Jesus say, what does the Bible say about the Holy Spirit? (John 16)
  - A. Sent by Jesus as a helper/counselor
  - B. Convicts the world of
    - 1. Sin non-belief
    - 2. Righteousness going to heaven
    - 3. Judgement works of evil
  - C. Guides you into all truth
    - 1. Truth of the Word
    - 2. Truth of Jesus
    - 3. Spirit leads us to Jesus and His Word
  - D. Glorifies Jesus
    - 1. Every song
    - 2. Every sermon
    - 3. Every prayer
    - 4. Every plea

Focus on Jesus

- E. He reveals His Plan
  - 1. God has a plan
  - 2. God gives us a vision of His Work in our lives by His Spirit
- III. What the Spirit brings, teaches, and creates in our lives
  - A. Word of God
    - 1. Inspired by the Spirit
  - B. The fruit (results) of the Spirit
    - 1. Love, joy, peace
    - 2. Patience, kindness, goodness
    - 3. Gentleness, self-control

- C. Gifts of the Spirit
  - 1. Wisdom
  - 2. Faith
  - 3. Distinguishing of spirits
- D. Seals our salvation the moment we believe (Ephesians 1:13)
- E. Helps us to pray

### IV. When does one receive the Spirit of God into their life?

- A. When you believe/receive Jesus for salvation
  - 1. Galatians 3
  - 2. Romans 8
  - 3. 2 Corinthians 5:17
- B. The power, presence, the person of the Spirit whereby we cry out "Abba Father"

### V. The problem we often have

- A. Though in a relationship with God, we feel a disconnect. Why?
  - 1. We grieve the Holy Spirit thus feeling convicted
  - 2. We quench the Holy Spirit
- B. The worst, the "unpardonable", the blasphemy...
  - 1. Turning down, rejecting the offer of salvation
  - 2. Dying in that state
  - 3. Cannot happen to a believer
  - 4. Must be a willful choice of the heart
