What We Believe About God Is Crucial To Our Life

- I. How we see God determines many things about us. Here are 3 things.
 - A. How/if I worship and who or what we worship
 - 1. We all worship something or someone
 - What happens in concert halls
 What happens in stadiums/arenas
 What happens in churches
 All have an interesting parallel
 - 3. The human mind is an idol factory
 - B. How I see myself
 - 1. Wonderfully made with a divine purpose and eternal meaning
 - 2. Or a cosmic accident being controlled by social constructs, that I can deconstruct, if I don't agree or like them
 - 3. So, is it about me or the One who created me?
 - C. What your message is about
 - 1. What's your message?
 - 2. What is it that you want people to know?
- II. What we know about the latest research that points to what we believe about God
 - A. The "tired," "old," and outdated arguments of the skeptic/atheist, agnostic (as critical thinking is allowed) have failed
 - B. The 5 nails in the skeptic's "coffin" of unbelief
 - 1. Fossil record doesn't support evolution
 - 2. DNA code of life points to intelligent design
 - 3. Prebiotic soup that could not have occurred
 - 4. Mathematical probability says random chance doesn't produce
 - 5. Biased intent with no scientific method
 - C. Seven scientific discoveries that point to God
 - Space-time theorems (Genesis 1:1)
 A beginning requires a beginner
 - 2. Universe expanding (11 scriptures)
 - 3. Laws of physics constant
 - a. Jeremiah 33, Ecclesiastes, Romans
 - 4. Fine tuning/dark matter
 - 5. Mathematical probability
 - 6. Observation

- D. The only argument left for the skeptic is the relational emotional argument
