- D. Reward given at the Believers Evaluation (1 Corinthians 3:12-15)
- E. God gives us gifts, what we do with those gifts is our gift to God
 - 1. Insults God to do nothing with our talent
 - 2. We and others lose when we don't use our gifts
- F. God created you for greatness

 - 2. He equipped you

- A. Skewed Understanding of Success
 - 1. Erroneous teaching
 - 2. Erroneous standards
- B. Selfish Pursuits
 - 1. Not about you
 - 2. Not about stuff
- C. Self-sabotage
 - 1. Not managing our decisions
 - 2. Believing we have "arrived"
 - 3. Never changing our thinking
 - 4. Not controlling our emotions
 - 5. Being out of position
- D. Standards that are Low
 - 1. Not wanting / trying to go to the top
 - 2. Not having a vision
 - 3. Settling for mediocrity
- E. Sick Relationships
 - 1. Bad company corrupts
 - 2. Beware who you listen to
 - 3. We become like those with whom we fellowship (hang out with)

- F. Stupid Decisions
 - 1. Every decision has a built-in consequence
 - 2. Biblical principles and physical laws will not be ignored
 - 3. God is not mocked
