FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

It's back to school as the summer break concludes for many students and teachers. Many are preparing for the routine of back to school, back to work, and back to "normal." The past few years have been a challenge to define what is normal, what is the new normal and what can we hope to consider as normal.

It seems our culture is going through a major shift as to what is reality versus what is the perception of the latest trend. Many seem to embrace what was once considered "magical thinking" and "let's pretend" as factual, truthful and scientifically verifiable. Many do not realize that some of the symptoms that some are displaying are considered a disorder or dysphoria by the "Diagnostic Manual of Mental Health (DSM-5)."

It seems that as this cultural shift begins to gain traction, many schools, organizations and churches are embracing what is counterfeit and treating it as reality. The concern is that the ramifications, and considerations are serious and indefinite in the lives of our children, adolescents and young adults.

The question is, how did this happen? How did we get here? One possibility is as our culture dismisses God from our society, then humanity can redefine what or how humanity can be defined. If God is not a part of our culture, then humanity can define who or what is human, and what is right or wrong.

For decades (possibly for centuries) humanity has tried to dismiss God from its social values, morals and laws. Whenever God (and His Word) is dismissed then the most powerful, loudest, and most aggressive get to have their way and determine what is real and in some cases, who gains and who loses.

However, when the words of Jesus are applied in a culture, and there is love, grace, and truth practiced, embraced and understood, then there is a sense of harmony, security and responsibility that allows our culture to prosper and promote what is reality.

In the month of August we will be teaching and preaching our "**Reasons to Believe**" series as we look at the reality of our faith and its impact on our lives, and in our relationships and our future.

I hope you will join us Sunday as we declare "**Reason to Believe: the Impact of God on our Lives.**"

WHAT ARE YOU FOCUSING ON? BY SAM LOBELLO



Isaiah 26:3-4 says, *"Thou, will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee, because he trusts in Thee. Trust in the LORD forever, for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength."*

I find myself quoting this verse often... sometimes to myself. This Old Testament Prophet reveals to us that God wants to bless us with inner peace and everlasting strength. You see, in these verses God promises us peace in the midst of life's storms and the strength to get through those storms. But there is one condition...we must keep our mind focused on God. Satan would have us focus our mind on anyone else or anything else, but the call of Scripture is that we discipline ourselves to keep our mind focused on God!

The best New Testament illustration of this principle is found in Matthew 14:28-30. After the miracle of Jesus feeding 5,000 from five loaves of bread and two fish, Jesus insisted that his disciples get back in the boat and cross to the other side of the lake. As the disciples got far away from land, a storm cropped up. The winds were strong and the waves were high. At 3 o'clock in the morning

they saw walking on the water what appeared to them to be a ghost. The disciples were terrified! Actually, it wasn't a ghost. It was Jesus walking on water as he was coming across the lake. Jesus spoke to the disciples and said, *"Don't be afraid. Have courage. It is I."* Seeking to validate that it was truly Jesus, Peter said to Jesus, *"If it is you, command me to come to You on the water."* Jesus said, *"Come."* As Peter was focused on Jesus and walking in obedience to His command, Peter was fine. He literally walked on water. But when he took His eyes off of Jesus and put them on the circumstances around him, he began to sink.

You and I face the same challenge today. Satan is a trickster and a deceiver. He will do all he can in an attempt to lure our focus off of Jesus and onto our circumstances. It is all-important that we stay focused on Jesus as we journey through life. For when we don't, we begin to sink. We begin to live in fear. Our inner peace turns into chaos and we begin to experience instability and feelings of powerlessness. We are not powerless for, *"Greater is He that is in us, than he that is in the world."* (1 John 4:4) The same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead dwells in the life of every believer...The Holy Spirit of God. We are not powerless! Might we discipline our lives to stay focused on Jesus. For as we do, we will find ourselves trusting in Him instead of being distracted by the circumstances around us, and as a result, experience what Isaiah the Prophet declared...perfect peace and everlasting strength.

LIVE OAK WORSHIP BY TRENT BARNETT



When we talk about worship, it's important to understand why we do what we do. When we sing to the Lord, we're not just singing songs we enjoy or melodies we like. There is something so much deeper to what is happening, something profoundly more biblical at hand when Christians gather and sing.

There are hundreds of Scriptures we could look at to better understand Christian worship, so let's look at one of those passages here. In Ephesians 5:18-20, Paul writes, "Be filled with the Spirit, as you sing psalms, and hymns, and spiritual songs among yourselves, singing and making melody to the Lord in your hearts, giving thanks to God the Father at all times and for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." Paul's desire is for Christ followers to be continually filled with the Spirit - an active, ongoing process, that helps us be more aware of the presence and power of God at work in our lives. So then, how are we to be continually filled with the Spirit?

The very next thing Paul says, the first example on how we are to be filled with the Spirit, is by singing. Don't miss this. When we gather as a body of believers to worship, God fills us with His Spirit. "Worship through singing helps us, and causes us to be filled with the Spirit. When we are filled with the Spirit, we have the power we need to walk out these doors and obey the Lord" (Matt Carter). Let's look at three ways Paul says this happens.

First, **SINGING HAS A SPIRITUAL IMPACT HORIZONTALLY.** Paul says we are filled with the Spirit as we "address one another." That's not the first thing we'd expect, right? The expectation would be, "be filled with the Spirit so to address the Lord." No, first Paul says to address one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. You see, singing isn't just for your own benefit. We are called to "edify one another" (1 Thess. 5:11), to build one another up. When we sing with the body of Christ, it helps those around us be filled. Your singing helps remind the person down the row from you who's going through

a difficult season, or the couple struggling in their marriage, that God is with them. It builds up their faith, and encourages them to worship, which builds up the people around them. It's this beautiful snowball effect within the body where hearts are being encouraged by one another, and believers are filled with the Spirit. That's worship.

Next, **SINGING HAS A SPIRITUAL IMPACT VERTICALLY.** Paul says to "sing and make melody to the Lord." Worship is defined as ascribing worth, showing value, to someone or something. For Christians, that worth is ascribed to God, as we recognize His power, celebrate His grace and faithfulness, and honor the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. Singing is one of the many ways we do this. Throughout Scripture, when people sense the power and presence of God, they fall on their faces, raise their voices in song, dance before the Lord, fall on their knees, lift their hands, and shout out praises to the Lord. It's the only fitting response to God's glory.

At times, the business and pressures of life can put us in a place where we don't really feel like worshiping, reading our Bible, or coming to church. Even when we don't feel like it, if we take that step to worship out of obedience, our souls are reminded of our love for the Lord. We're reminded of His faithfulness and His goodness, and it renews in our hearts Godly passions and pursuits. This renewal helps us worship the Lord more freely, which in turn, encourages the people around us to do the same.

Third, **SINGING HELPS US GIVE THANKS.** When our hearts are reminded of all God has done, it overwhelms us with thankfulness - which in turn fills us with His Spirit. The Lord has been faithful through so many seasons

and generations. If for no other reason than this, He is worthy of all our praise. As believers, our lives have been radically changed because of the blood of Jesus Christ. "If you...can't worship God for no other reason than for thankfulness out of what He's done for you, something is radically wrong. If your heart is never moved to worship, something is missing in your life" (Matt Carter). Giving thanks is an essential part of worshiping the Lord.

When we gather as believers to worship, we are engaging in a profoundly Biblical activity. We worship so we may be filled with the Spirit, so we can walk in the power and presence of the living God. Hebrews 8:5 says that worship on earth is merely "a copy and shadow of what is in Heaven." Corporate worship aligns our hearts with the worship that is going on in Heaven as you read this. May our worship on earth draw our hearts closer to the Lord as we encourage one another to do the same, singing to one another and to the Lord. This is how our lives, and those around us, are continually filled with the Spirit of God.

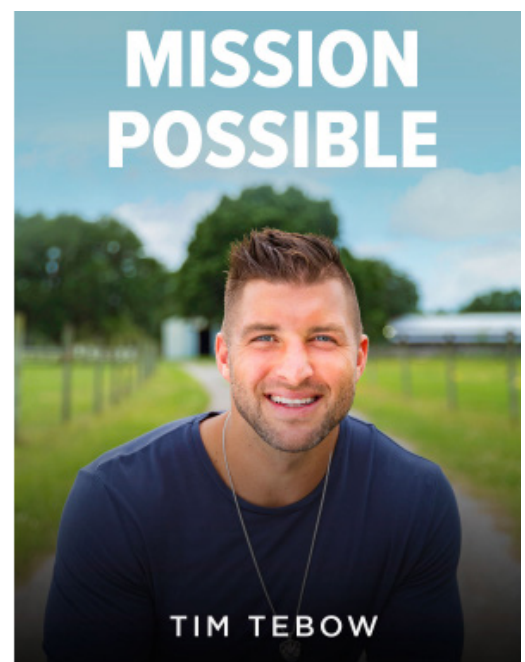

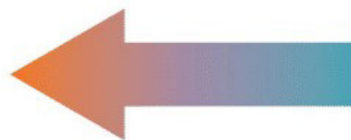
