- B. In the garden, humanity wanted to be as God (knowing good from evil)
- C. In Joshua 24:14-15 (which God will you choose)
- D. In 1 Kings 18:21 (the choice of God or Baal)
- E. During the 1st century Christians had to choose
 - 1. Caesar is Lord
 - 2. Jesus is Lord
- F. The question today is... is Allah God or is Yahweh God?

 - 1. Restricting (our rights, privileges and opportunities)
 - 2. Legally prohibiting
 - 3. Deriding/Insulting
 - 4. Abusing
 - 5. Canceling (cancel culture)
 - 6. Censoring
 - 7. Redefining words, terms

- 8. Excluding
- 9. Ignoring

- B. In the first 300 years of the church, followers of Jesus faced persecution from religious leaders (Saul of Tarsus) and government (Nero, Domitian)

- A. When you proclaim/stand for Jesus as Lord
- B. When you teach others (Jesus is Lord)
- C. When you go against the cultural norm (stand on Scripture)
- D. When you say, "The Bible says"
 - 1. This infuriates forces of darkness
 - 2. These forces recognize the power and authority of Scripture
